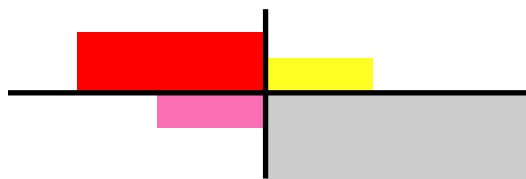

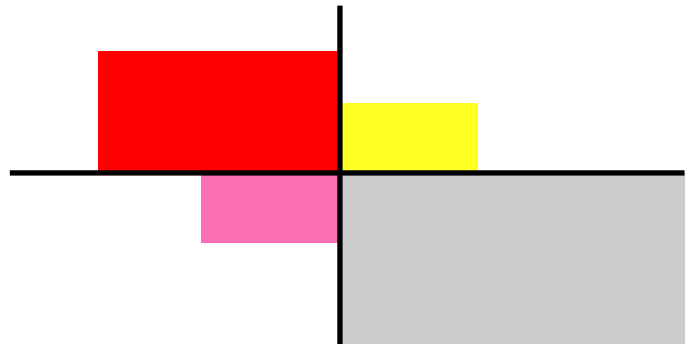
After the recent storms, lots of yard cleanup was needed and Eric Finks and his crew did a great job getting it done—thank you so much!
