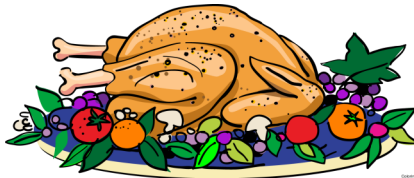
Blanket Sunday
