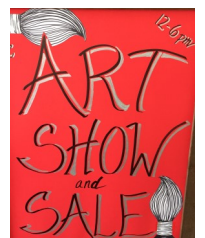
All Saints Commemoration Sunday

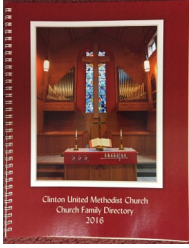
On Sunday, November 6th, we will honor all members that have passed away in the last 12 months. A bell will be rung and a book will be dedicated to the church library in their memory.
