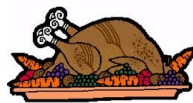
United Methodist Men's Chili Supper

and tea will all be available

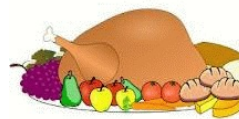
